Minutes of regular meeting 7/10/24

Dave Burke called the meeting to order at 12pm

- MEETING REMARKS:** After the Pledge of Allegiance, the treasurer's report and secretary's report for the May meeting was accepted by the membership.
- SECRETARY'S REPORT:** The secretary's report for the May meeting was posted to the website prior to acceptance by the membership.
- TRESURER'S REPORT:** The treasurer's report for the May meeting was posted to the website prior to acceptance by the membership.
- DELEGATE'S REPORT:** Rod Cameron was not in attendance; Dave Metzger gave us a brief update from the delegates meeting on the 7th of June in Albany. SLMS will be not be used by the department of state for training going forward. The new system, however will not keep the historical record of past training. The lobbyist for NYSBOC is continuing to try to keep legislation from mistakenly duplicating or removing part of the code when developing new laws.
- EDUCATION:** Dave Metzger reports that January 28-30th at the Marriot will be the next year's training. We are starting to get approvals for training. Sign ups will be available earlier this year and anyone interested may want to register early as it is easier to drop someone that changes their mind than to get someone in at the last minute. It usually sells out, so there will likely be a waiting list. People on the waiting list would then be placed as people decide to opt out.
- NEW/OLD BUSINESS:** Scholarship reimbursement applications are starting to come in, but need to be in before the deadline in August.
